Materials
Bernat® Mega Bulky ${ }^{\text {mim }}$ (10.5 oz/300 g; 64 yds/58 m)
Contrast A New Gold Contrast B Teal (88206) 2 balls Size U.S. PIQ $(15 \mathrm{~mm}) / 12 \mathrm{~mm}$ crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. ABBREVIATIONS Approx = Approximately Beg $=$ Beginning $\mathrm{Ch}=$ Chain(s) Hdc = Half double croche $\dagger$ Pat $=$ Pattern Rem = Remaining

Rep $=$ Repeat
RS = Right side
Sc = Single croche $\dagger$
SI st = Slip stitch
St(s) $=$ Stitch $($ es $)$
Tog = Together

INSTRUCTIONS


Note: Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as hdc.To join colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of previous color. Draw new color through loops and proceed with new color. PILLOW FRONT **With A, ch 32. 1st row: (RS). SI st in 2 nd ch from hook. *1 hdc in next ch. Sl st in next ch. Rep from * to end of chain. Turn. 31 sts. 2nd row: Ch 2.1 hdc in first sl st. *SI st in next hdc. 1 hdc in next sl st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. 3rd row: Ch 1. SI st in first hdc. *1 hdc in next sl st. Sl st in next hdc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn. ** Rep last 2 rows for pat 3 times more, then rep 2 nd row once, joining $B$ at end of last row. With $B$, work 4 rows in pat, joining $A$ at end of last row. With A, work 2 rows in pat, joining $B$ at end of last row. With $B$, work 4 rows in pat, joining $A$ at end of last row.

With A, work 10 rows in pat. Fasten off.
PILLOW BACK
Work from ** to ** as given for Pillow Front. Rep last 2 rows for pat until 30 rows in total have been worked.
Fasten off.
Finishing
Sew 3 sides of Pillow tog leaving 1 side open. Insert pillow form. Sew rem side closed.

Materials
Bernat® Blanket ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ ( $10.5 \mathrm{oz} / 300 \mathrm{~g} ; 220$ yds/201 m) or (5.3 oz/150 g; $108 \mathrm{yds} / 98 \mathrm{~m}$ ) Small Version Dark Grey (10044) or (00044) 235 yds/215 m or 2 (3) balls Large Version Light Teal (10734) or (00734) $380 \mathrm{yds} / 345 \mathrm{~m}$ or 2 (4) balls
Size U.S. K/10.5 (6.5 mm ) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge. Stitch marker.

Small: Approx 1012" [ 26.5 cm ] diameter $\times 12$ " $[30.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] high. Large: Approx $131 / 2$ " 34.5 cm ] diameter $\times 14$ " [ 35.5 cm ] high. GAUGE
9 sc and 10 rows $=4$ " $[10 \mathrm{~cm}$ ]. INSTRUCTIONS
Ch 2.
1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with sl st in first sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.2 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st in first sc. 12 sc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 18 sc.
4th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc .

5th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 3 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 30 sc.
6th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc . Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 36 sc.
7th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 5 sc . Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 42 sc.
8th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 48 sc.

9th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 7 sc . Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 54 sc.
10th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc . Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 60 sc.

11th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 9 sc . Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 66 sc. 12th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 10 sc . Rep from *around. Join with sl st in first sc. 72 sc. 13th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 11 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 78 sc. Large Version only: 14th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 12 sc. Rep from * around. Join with sl st in first sc. 84 sc. 15th rnd: Ch

1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 13 sc . Rep from*around. Join with sl st in first sc. 90 sc. 16th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 14 sc . Rep from *around. Join with sl st in first sc. 96 sc. 17th rnd: Ch 1. *2 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 15 sc . Rep from *around. Join with sl st in first sc. 102 sc. Both Versions: Next rnd: Ch 1. Working into back loops only, 1 sc in each sc around. Join with sl st in first sc. Place marker at end of rnd.

Next rnd: Ch 1. Working into both loops,
1 sc in each sc around.
Join with sl st in first sc.
Rep last rnd until work from marked rnd measures 10 (12)" [25.5 (30.5) cm]. Do not fasten off. Handles: 1st rnd: Ch 1.1
sc in each of
next 16 (22) sc. Ch 6.
Skip next 6 sc. 1 sc
in each of next 33 (45)
sc. Ch 6. Skip next
6 sc .1 sc in each of next
17 (23) sc. Join
with sl st in first sc.
2nd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in
each of next 16
(22) sc. 10 sc in next
ch-6 sp. 1 sc in each
of next 33 (45) sc. 10 sc
in next ch-6 sp.
1 sc in each of next 17
(23) sc. Join with
sl st to first sc.
3rd rnd: Ch 1.1 sc in each
sc around. Join
with sl st to first sc. 86
(110) sc. Fasten off.

# Spiral Rug 

crocheted with fabric strips


How to Cut Fabric Strips

## STEP 1

Fold fabric in half, bringing the selvage edges together and making sure they are even. Fold again in this direction, bringing the center fold up to $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ below the selvage edges.

## STEP 2

Using a rotary cutter, cut fabric strips, cutting through the folds, but NOT through the selvages.


## Materials

-Use any color fabric you desire. Knit fabric and cotton work best.
-Need 3.5 yards of fabric
-Need a 10.00mm Jumbo Amour Crochet hook or any Jumbo Amour to obtain gauge. -Rotary cutter -Straight edge


Tip: don't worry if the lines are not toostraight, it will not show.


## STEP 3

Unfold fabric by separating the selvages. Now begin cutting into strips: at the top of the fabric, cut the first strip then cut every two. for the bottom strips you cut every two.

## For bottom strips, start cutting every

Then wrap continuous strip around an object such as a slender box.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Makes a 19in diameter round rug
Stitches used are Chain St (Ch) and Single Crochet (sc)
Begin: Ch 4 and join to form a ring.

1. Ch $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each ch. Join. ( 8 sc ).
2. Ch $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each ch. Join ( 16 sc ).
3. Ch 1, *sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc*. Repeat from * to* around. Join ( 24 sc ). 4. Ch 1, *sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc*. Repeat from *to * around. Join
4. Repeat round 4 until piece measures


You can mix and match your fabrics or use one color tone.
